RESOLUTION AND ORDER FIXING BOUNDARIES AND CALLING ELECTION ON FORMATION OF

PINYON PINES COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, a patition for the formation of a County water district has been duly presented to this Board in conformance with Section 30201 of the Water Code after due proceedings before and approval by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the proposal to form such district, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the petition is genuine and sufficient and that the notice of the public hearing thereon was duly given in the manner and in the time prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, all proceedings prescribed by law for the formation of the proposed County water district have been duly complied with; and this Board has, as it deemed advisable pursuant to Section 30264, made no changes in the proposed boundaries of the proposed district as they were approved by the Local Agency Formation Commission; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 3, 1969, as follows:

- That the name of the proposed district shall be "Pinyon Pines County Water District".
- 2. That the boundaries of the proposed district are hereby established and described as follows:

- 5. That the County Clerk shall cause a notice of election to be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Riverside once a week for two weeks before said election pursuant to Section 30293.
